

# How Do I Join the Teen Summer Reading Club?

1. Visit the *George and Cynthia Woods Mitchell Library* on or after *June 6th*.

2. Register for the Teen Summer Reading Club at the 2nd Floor Reference Desk by filling out a Book Log Card and signing up to participate in the Teen Summer Reading Programs.

3. Next, receive your book bag filled with goodies and choose a paperback. You may keep this paperback or exchange it for a new one the next time you return to the library.

4. Each time you visit the library, between June 6th and July 29th, write down all the books you have read on your Book Log Card. Make sure to reach your personal Book Goal by July 29th. All teens who reach their personal Book Goal may attend the VIP End of Summer Reading Party.

5. Attend the VIP End of Summer Reading Party for teens on July 30th, 2009. Pizza and goodies will be served as well as a live D.J., and everyone who attends the party will be entered into drawings to win gift cards and prizes.

6. Teens are encouraged to read a wide variety of fiction and nonfiction books within their own personal reading and age levels. Several lists of award books are available at the 2nd Floor Reference Desk.

7. Sign-up is required for all Teen Summer Reading Club Programs. Space is limited and available on a first-come-first-served basis, so sign up for all programs at the beginning of the summer.
